Fraser Fir Facts

- The Fraser fir was named after John Fraser, a Scottish botanist who explored the southern Appalachian Mountains in the late 1700s.
- North Carolina produces 26% of real Christmas trees in the US and ranks #2 nationally for number of trees harvested annually.
- The iconic Fraser fir represents nearly 95% of all Christmas tree species grown in NC.
- Christmas trees are raised in more than a dozen western NC counties (Alleghany, Ashe and Avery are among the top producers).
- In 2005, the Fraser fir was adopted as the official Christmas tree of NC.
- Fraser firs are known as "the Cadillac of Christmas trees" due to their needle retention, strong branches and pleasant aroma.
- It can take between 7 to 10 years to grow a 6- to 7-foot Fraser fir.
- Since 1961, a North Carolina Fraser fir has appeared as the official White House Christmas tree a record 13 times.
- While the Fraser fir is the only fir indigenous to the Great Smoky Mountains National Park, a tiny invasive insect called the Balsam Wooly Adelgid has killed 90% of mature fir trees in the park since 1962.

Let's celebrate life, each other, and the rebuilding process that will take a while. There is still no place in the world better than Henderson County, North Carolina – not just because of our natural beauty, but because of the citizens who call this place their home!
